ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of Harland & Wolff Methil Ltd. (HWM) to reduce its impact on the environment through a process of continual improvement in its environmental performance and prevention of pollution during its activities. To achieve this HWM shall establish and retain an effective Environmental Management System (EMS).

The EMS will be planned and implemented to reflect the activities of HWM with regard to their effect on the environment and monitored and retained through the HWM's Environmental Operating Procedures.

The environmental performance of HWM shall be subject to a formal annual management review meeting by Senior Management, which includes review of this environmental policy statement, setting and monitoring of objectives.
- Senior Management has established, implemented and retained this environmental policy, which is delivered through HWM's Environmental Management System.
- HWM shall actively promote continual improvement in environmental performance through operational monitoring of objectives and effective application of its policies and procedures.
- HWM's environmental management programme has Senior management commitment, who shall ensure that this documented policy is communicated to and understood by all interested parties and that it is resourced and implemented to meet our defined environmental objectives and targets.
- Leaders, Management, employees and contractors have a responsibility both as individuals and collectively to ensure all work undertaken, minimises effects to the environment.
- To ensure the successful implementation of the HWM's policy, a representative shall be appointed with the authority and responsibility to maintain the environmental management system.
- In its day-to-day operation, and long-term strategy, HWM shall act in a socially responsible manner, committing to comply with all applicable legal requirements, and with other requirements, relating to its environmental aspects. Additionally they shall contribute positively towards improvement of the environments in which operates.
- Regular environmental audits of the aspects of HWM's activities shall be carried out to ensure the effective implementation of this environmental policy and to lessen the likelihood of environmental damage.
- HWM shall provide public access to information on its environmental policy and performance when requested.

This policy will be reviewed every two years (or more frequently if there have been significant changes in the type and nature of our activities) and revised as required to ensure it remains current and appropriate for the business.
